The University of Florida's College of Medicine invites applications and nominations for the position of Chair of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology has a tradition of excellence in clinical service, education and research. Eighteen clinical faculty members and 17 residents provide comprehensive clinical services in the areas of obstetrics, gynecology, reproductive endocrinology and infertility, oncology and maternal/fetal medicine. Four research faculty are actively and collaboratively engaged in studies of high risk pregnancy, reproductive endocrinology, and molecular regulation of ovarian and uterine diseases. The department chair is responsible for promoting the individual scholarship of the department faculty, providing leadership in executing the department's vision to enhance its clinical, education and research missions and working closely with institutional leaders to promote academic excellence. The successful candidate must possess an MD or MD/PhD, be board certified in Obstetrics/Gynecology, possess or be eligible for licensure as a physician in the state of Florida, and must be an individual with a national reputation and a record of distinguished academic achievement. We also seek an individual who has proven leadership skills and will be able to build upon the strengths of the current department to enhance the established academic programs and establish new opportunities. This is a full-time, tenure-accruing faculty appointment at the rank of Associate or full Professor.
