The University of Florida's College of Medicine invites applications and nominations for the position of Chair of the Department of Radiation Oncology. The Department of Radiation Oncology has a tradition of excellence in clinical service, education and research. Twelve clinical faculty members, 14 medical physics faculty members and nine residents located on the College of Medicine's Gainesville and Jacksonville campuses provide comprehensive clinical services in all modalities of radiation oncology, including the recently commissioned Florida Proton Therapy Institute. Department faculty also are extensively involved in institutional clinical oncology trials.

The department chair is responsible for promoting the individual scholarship of the department faculty, providing leadership in executing the department's vision to enhance its clinical, education and research missions and working closely with institutional leaders to promote academic excellence. The successful candidate must possess an MD or MD/PhD, be board certified in Radiation Oncology, possess or be eligible for licensure as a physician in the state of Florida, and must be an individual with a national reputation and a record of distinguished academic achievement. We also seek an individual who has proven leadership skills and will be able to build upon the strengths of the current department to enhance the established academic programs and establish new opportunities. This is a full-time, tenure-accruing faculty appointment at the rank of Associate or full Professor.
