The meeting began with a discussion of the 2006 Graduation Questionnaire data and the power point presentation that will be presented by Dr. Watson at the Executive LCME Retreat. Members commented that it appeared that UF COM scored very well.

The Anatomy by Diagnostic Imaging was discussed with Dr. Sstrom, course director of the course. Dr. Sstrom asked if the score that were presented in the table was for the syllabus and the course report. Dr. Rarey confirmed that they were. Dr. Sstrom suggested that there be a format for the course report that is given to the course directors. He felt that the having a format would give the course directors more time to devote to their narrative comments. Dr., Kellner stated that once you have done one course report, you have established your own template. Dr. Sstrom stated that next year there will be a required text for the course that he hopes will be a very beneficial addition. Dr. Ritz asked why the course was pass/fail. Dr. Sstrom stated that they wanted it to be a positive experience for the students. Dr. Rarey stated that someone will be in contact with Dr. Sstrom to help him revise his syllabus.

The neuroscience course results were then shared and discussed. Both the syllabus and the course report received fairly high scores. Dr. Ritz stated that he didn't have any questions for the committee.

Dr. Ritz asked whether the Jr. Honors Program should be addressed by the subcommittee. There was a differential response. The chair of the Curriculum committee will be asked to respond to this question.
