Dr. Rarey began the meeting by stating that he wanted to go review a few courses at a time. All course director reports have been submitted with the exception of Clinical Radiology. Dr. Davidson will be in attendance at our next meeting. Lou Ann pointed out the IFH does not fit the grading format that the other courses fall under. Dr. Kellner asked when do you start being a professional. Dr. Hahn stated that she felt that it begins before medical school. In regards to competency vs. grades, what is unprofessional in the first two years? Speaking in lectures, Dr. Rarey felt that it starts with the faculty setting a good example to be modeled after. The student asked how the faculty determines the grade for professionalism for each student. Dr. Hahn feels that sometimes students are graded on their personalities.
