

## Evaluation Subcommittee 2/28/07

**Present:** Drs. Rarey Ritz Novak, Kellner, Cooper, Karle

**Guest:** Dr. Juan Cendan, Medical Director of the Harrell Center

Dr. Cendan met with the Evaluation Subcommittee to discuss the annual PBE report. He noted that feedback was sent out to students. At some point, the students will need to be asked how helpful this feedback is. There was a discussion about those students that are having trouble and whether or not the academic status committee needs to be notified. It was stated that the course and clerkship directors also need to be notified.

Dr. Cendan clarified the PBE stands for Performance-Based Evaluation. The PBE Oversight Committee met and discussed all the students that performed poorly on the PBEs. The committee does not currently view videos of these students. The objective's section for PBE 3 needs to be updated so that it relates to the competencies. Dr. Cendan stated that the students who perform poorly on PBE 1 and PBE 2 return to the Harrell Center for remediation; for PBE 3, students who perform poorly are harder to remediate. Dr. Cendan stated that this should be the job of the clerkships. It was suggested that the PBE oversight committee members might be able to review student videos. Dr. Cendan stated that they are working towards automating the post-encounter notes.

Dr. Rarey congratulated the evaluation subcommittee for a successful LCME visit; the learning objective and the competency based curriculum were highly evaluated by the survey team.
